



POLICY ON PRACTICE ICE

March 29, 2018

Policy Statement

The City of Brampton (CoB) may offer open sheets of ice to Brampton Curling Club (BCC) members for the purpose of unstructured practice. This practice ice is offered free of charge at the discretion of the CoB and may only be used on a drop-in basis (it cannot be reserved by ahead of time). Individuals may choose to rent sheets of ice from the CoB, however, this must be done independent of the Brampton Curling Club (BCC).

Definitions

Practice Ice is defined as ice donated by the CoB to the members of BCC for unstructured practice.

Rental Ice for Practice is defined as ice which is rented and reserved by an individual/team for a specific day/time slot. Rental Ice for Practice must be booked directly through the CoB and paid for by the individual booking the ice.

General Guidelines

Practice Ice

Notification of Practice Ice is offered at the discretion of the City of Brampton approximately one week ahead of time and is posted at the club and on the BCC facebook/twitter accounts.

In the event of a private rental, the CoB may cancel Practice Ice at any time. Members should call 905-451-4015 ext. 62272 prior to arriving to confirm the Practice Ice is still available.

All members using Practice Ice must sign in using the Practice Ice sign-in sheet.

Practice Ice may only be used for unstructured practice. Drills or use of equipment (pylons, targets, etc.) are prohibited.

Practice Ice should be shared by multiple members. Up to four (4) members may use the same Practice Ice at the same time. In the event there are more than four (4) members per sheet on hand for Practice Ice:

- Limit your practice session to 20-minutes.
- Members may return to the ice for additional sessions once other members have practiced for their 20-minute session.

Rental Ice for Practice

As Rental Ice for Practice is not affiliated with the BCC, it may be used in any manner (drills, games, throwing of rocks, etc.), does not need to be shared with other BCC members and may be used for the full rental time period.
