



Registration Rules and Deadlines

(2018-2019 Season)

General Registration Rules

- All registrations must be submitted by completing the online registration form on the club website at www.bramptoncc.com
- Once a member has submitted their online registration, the full membership fee is due immediately. The preferred method is electronic payment by credit card using the website. Cheques or e-Transfers can also be used by contacting the BCC Club Administrator (info@bramptoncc.com) to make arrangements. A member is not considered to be registered until their payment is received, so failure to provide prompt payment may lead to other peoples' registrations being processed first.
- Registration for a league does not guarantee entry into that league
- A member cannot be confirmed a place in any league, or added to any league roster, until they have paid in full
- Members must be registered and paid in full to be included on a league waiting list

Key Registration Dates

Member Registration: August 15th

Public Registration: August 29th

Youth Registration¹: September 15th

Registration Priority

Existing members of the Brampton Curling Club of any type (Adult Members, Youth Members, Social Members, etc) have priority over new members when signing up the following season. This is accomplished by opening registration for existing members two weeks before public registration is opened.

Registration priority works slightly differently in each type of league, as described below:

Priorities for filling 4-Player CYO Leagues

1) Gold Level League Sponsors

- If requested, a Gold Level League Sponsor can reserve one team slot per draw time that they sponsor. This must be requested before registration starts.
- All team members must have registered and paid by the **Youth Registration** date, or they lose their priority

2) Returning Teams to a League

- A returning team is one where at least 3 members of the new team played together in the same league during previous season
- A team can hold their spot if:
 - At least 3 of the members from the team are returning

¹ Applies to youth teams entering in Adult Leagues. Youth can sign up for youth Little Rock and Bantam programs on the member/public registration dates.



Registration Rules and Deadlines

(2018-2019 Season)

- 4 team members have signed up and paid by the **Public Registration** date
- The league has at least as many spots available for returning teams as the previous year (otherwise it's the first-N teams to meet these guidelines)
- A team with 3 returning members who is bringing a new member into the club can have this person sign up during member registration period (before **Public Registration**) by requesting this exception from the Club Administrator (info@bramptoncc.com).

3) Returning Club Members

- Returning club members can sign up for any league prior to the public registration date, but they usually cannot be confirmed a spot until the **Public Registration** date
 - Any spots not taken by club sponsors/returning teams will be filled by accepting the full-teams once 4 team members have signed up and paid, on a first-come, first-served basis
 - Teams will be notified as soon as possible if they were accepted into a league; usually within 48 hours of the **Public Registration** date
- A team with 3 returning members who is bringing a new member into the club can have this person sign up during member registration period (before **Public Registration**) by requesting this exception from the Club Administrator (info@bramptoncc.com)

4) Public Registration

- Once public registration opens, any remaining spots will be filled by accepting full-teams once 4 players have signed up and paid, on a first-come, first-served basis
- If there are partial teams or individual entries, the convener will try to match these players up into teams as quickly as possible.
 - All such assignments are best-effort, and the players involved have the option to accept these matches or not.
 - At least one member from each group of players should be easily contactable during the registration period to facilitate quick decisions on player assignments
- A partial team cannot hold a place in a league, so if they decline a match, they may lose their spot to a full team

5) Youth Registration

- A team where at least 2 players meet the CurlON U21 age criteria is defined as a youth team
- A new youth team cannot register until the **Youth Registration** date, after which the normal public registration rules apply
- A returning youth team is grandfathered in and exempt from this rule if at least 3 of the players played together in the same league in the previous season

Priorities for filling 2-Player CYO Leagues

1) Gold Level League Sponsors

- If requested, a Gold Level League Sponsor can reserve one team slot per draw time that they sponsor. This must be requested before registration starts.

- All team members must have registered and paid by the **Youth Registration** date, or they lose their priority

2) Returning Teams to a League

- A returning team is one where 2 members of the new team played together in the same league during previous season
- A team can hold their spot if:
 - At least 2 of the members from the team are returning
 - 2 team members have signed up and paid by the **Public Registration** date
 - The league has at least as many spots available for returning teams as the previous year (otherwise it's the first-N teams to meet these guidelines)

3) Returning Club Members

- Returning club members can sign up for any league prior to the public registration date, but they usually cannot be confirmed a spot until the **Public Registration** date
 - Any spots not taken by club sponsors/returning teams will be filled by accepting the full-teams of 2 players once 2 team members have signed up and paid, on a first-come, first-served basis
 - Teams will be notified as soon as possible if they were accepted into a league; usually within 48 hours of the **Public Registration** date

4) Public Registration

- Once public registration opens, any remaining spots will be filled by accepting full-teams once 2 players have signed up and paid, on a first-come, first-served basis
- If there are individual entries, the convener will try to match these players up into teams as quickly as possible.
 - All such assignments are best-effort, and the players involved have the option to accept these matches or not.
 - All players should be easily contactable during the registration period to facilitate quick decisions on player assignments
- A partial team cannot hold a place in a league, so if they decline a match, they may lose their spot to a full team

5) Youth Registration

- A team where at least 2 members meet the CurlON U21 age criteria is defined as a youth team
- A new youth team cannot register until the **Youth Registration** date, after which the normal public registration rules apply
- A returning youth team is grandfathered in and exempt from this rule if at least 2 of the players played together in the same league in the previous season

Priorities for filling 4-Player Club Leagues

1) Gold Level League Sponsors

- If requested, a Gold Level League Sponsor can reserve up to 4 individual spots per draw time that they sponsor. This must be requested before registration starts.
 - These players are NOT guaranteed to play together; normal Club Curling rules apply
- All players must have registered and paid by the **Youth Registration** date, or they lose their priority

2) Returning Members to a League

- Each individual member returning to a Club League can hold their spot if:
 - They have signed up and paid by the **Public Registration** date
 - The league has at least as many spots available for returning teams as the previous year (otherwise it's the first-N individuals to meet these guidelines)

3) Returning Club Members

- Returning club members can sign up for any league prior to the public registration date, but they usually cannot be confirmed a spot until the **Public Registration** date
 - Any spots not taken by club sponsors/returning members will be filled by accepting individuals on a first-come, first-served basis
 - Players will be notified as soon as possible if they were accepted into a league; usually within 48 hours of the **Public Registration** date

4) Public Registration

- Once public registration opens, any remaining spots will be filled by accepting individual entries on a first-come, first-served basis

5) Youth Registration

- Individuals members meet the CurlON U21 age criteria is defined as youth entries
- A new youth member cannot register until the **Youth Registration** date, after which the normal public registration rules apply
- A returning youth member is grandfathered into the league and exempt from this rule if they played in the same league during the previous season

Youth Curlers

- Bantam curlers may play in adult leagues, subject to the approval of the league convener. This approval is only subject to the curler being of sufficient age, skill, and maturity to play in an adult league.
 - A Bantam curler is one who is registered for the BCC Bantam Program, or who would normally play with adult rocks (not little rocks)
 - The Bantam membership fee will be considered the Membership Fee, and they are not required to also pay the Adult membership fee
 - They are eligible for the Young Adult discount off their first Adult league fee
- Little Rock curlers cannot play in adult leagues



Registration Rules and Deadlines (2018-2019 Season)

- A Little Rock curler is one who is registered in the BCC Little Rock Program, or who would normally play with little rocks (not adult rocks)
- Youth Entries/Teams² may enter any adult league, however, they cannot register until the **Youth Registration** date to allow both existing and new adult teams the opportunity to register first
 - Any youth team returning to the **same league** is grandfathered in and exempt from this rule
 - Youth playing on an adult team are not subject to this waiting period

Half-Year Membership

- Members playing for half the season will be charged as follows:
 - Half year league fee per league
 - Full year membership fee
 - Full year rate for locker and any other optional fees
- Members will be considered full members for the period they are playing in a league, and social members for the remainder of the season. They are not eligible to spare in any leagues when they are a social Member.
- League Conveners have the option to determine if they are willing to accept Half-Year members in their leagues
- It is not possible to sign up online for a Half-Year Membership; members should get in touch with the Club Administrator (info@bramptoncc.com)

Pro-Rated Registrations

- Members who sign up for a league midway through the season are eligible for pro-rated membership on the league fees.
 - League fees are pro-rated based on the numbers of weeks out of the 22-week season that are remaining at the time of the registration. For example, if they sign up with 19 weeks remaining, they pay 19/22 of the league fee.
 - Adult base membership fees (including Adult Member, Bantam, Little Rock, Spare-Only, Social Member and OCA Members) are not eligible for proration.
 - Additional registration options (including Lockers) are not eligible for proration.

All Registration Dates

At the AGM (Annual General Meeting)

- League structure and fees will be announced at the latest at the AGM (usually held in April)
- League structure and fees will be emailed out to all members and posted on the club website within 7 days of the AGM.

² The definition of Youth Entries/Teams varies from league-to-league, as defined in the Registration Priorities section.



Registration Rules and Deadlines

(2018-2019 Season)

On August 15th

- Registration is opened online for existing members

On August 29th

- Registration is opened to the public for new members to the club.
- New members have the same priority for entry into a league as returning members.

First Half of September

- At least 1 in-person registration night will be held in the first half of September.
 - All leagues must have a representative in attendance for these in-person registration times, preferably the league convener
 - Board of Director and Membership Committee representatives will also be required to attend and assist with registration duties as assigned.

On September 15th

- A team selected by a Gold Level league sponsor for a reserved spot in that league must have all members of the team registered and paid by September 15th to secure their spot. If all members are not signed up by this date they lose their reserved spot and follow the normal league registration rules.
- Youth teams may register in all Adult Leagues as of this date.

7 days before the first game of each league

- Leagues convenors must provide players with the time of their first game time at least 7 days before the first draw time for that league
